The following notes, changes, additions, and replacements shall be incorporated into the Project Manual or drawings as applicable:

ITEM 1. EXISTING CONDITIONS

While performing sewer line replacement, Contractor made the water line service connection at Durkee Street, installing 2" water service pipe (17' lf+/- and a 2" gate valve behind the sidewalk. In addition, due to field conditions, the manhole within the park was installed with inverts 4' lower. Please refer to attached updated C100 and L100.

ITEM 2. BID FORM - PLUMBING

See attached revised Bid Form- Plumbing.

Item 13 – Water Service Pipe (2") 143 LF

Item 17 – Gate Valve (2") 1 EA

Item 19 – Water Service connection shall be made to the newly installed 2" gate valve.

ITEM 3. CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS

1. Contractor requested bid results from June 2020 bid of complete project (which included the sewer line work). Bid results are attached.

2. Contractor asked whether there is a budget for this project.

This project is part of the City's DRI award (Streetscapes), which was for multiple projects, but there is not a specific budget available for this project.

4. Please clarify responsibility for trenching and backfill (by GC, or by each contractor?). Note: Conflict between C100 notes and Summary/Bid Form specs.

Each contractor is responsible for the trenching and backfill incidental to their work, as per the Summary and the respective Bid Forms. C100 has been updated.

5. In review of the quality control section of the general conditions, it mentions for the contractor to provide and hire testing services. Can you tell us what tests and quantity of each you are referring to? ie. Compaction of subgrade and frequency in between tests, concrete testing and frequency of testing, etc.

Each spec section notes the type of testing required; e.g., Concrete (03 3000) – see section 3.08 and for Earthwork (31 2200) see section 3.07.

6. Question was asked regarding MWBE requirements, and whether they apply per contractor or to the overall project.

As stated in the Notice to Bidders:

"The City is required to make a "good faith effort" to provide contracting opportunities for both MBE and WBE subcontractors. As a result, bidders are encouraged to provide opportunities for NYS-certified minority-and women-owned businesses. The goal for this project is 30% MWBE participation. This applies overall to the DRI grant projects under the Streetscape and Riverfront Access projects, of which this park revitalization is one part. A GC bidding on the project, that happens to be an MBE or WBE, is acceptable and will fulfill the requirement for this project. Combinations are also acceptable and do not have to be an even 15%/15% split between MBE and WBE participants.

The successful bidder will be required to provide an Affirmative Action and Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Policy Statement prior to the award of a contract."

The 30% goal applies to each contract (GC, Plumbing, Electrical). Each contractor (i.e. each prime per contract) should document efforts to reach out to and provide opportunities for MWBE subcontractors and/or suppliers.




