LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1975

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 144 OF CHAPTER 260 OF THE
LAWS OF 1902 AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF 1949
FOR THE PURPOSE OF BRINGING SAID SECTION INTO CON-
FORMITY WITH THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW OF THE STATE
OF NEW YORK, AND TO SUBSTITUTE THE WORD ASSESSOR FOR
ASSESSORS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the
City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 147 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902
as amended by Local Law No. 9 of 1949 is hereby further amended
to read as follows:

Section 147 Tentative Completion of the
Roll: The assessor on or before the first
day of June in each year shall complete
such tentative assessment roll, retaining
one copy in his office in City Hall. The
assessor shall forthwith cause a notice as
set forth in section 1526 of the Real Pro-
perty Tax Law of the State of New York to
be published once in the official news-
paper of said City and stating that such
roll shall be completed and filed and that
all persons interested may examine the
same at the City Assessor's Office until
the third Tuesday of June next ensuing,
at the place specified in such notice, at
which time the Board of Assessment Review
will hear complaints with respect to any
assessments.

SECTION II: This act shall take effect ^{on January 1, 1976} / after public

hearing and approval by the Mayor.
