LOCAL LAW NO. 11 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 150 of Chapter 269 of the
Laws of 1902 relating to levy of taxes by the Common Council.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of
Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 150 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902
is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 150.- Levy of taxes by Common Council- Tax Roll.
The Common Council must annually cause to be levied and raised by
general taxes upon all taxable property in the city according to
the valuations upon the assessment roll for the current year,
corrected as aforesaid:

1. The amount of taxes certified to the Common Council
of the City by the Board of Supervisors to be assessed by the city.
2. The amount of all interest and any installment of
principal falling due upon bonded or other funded debts of the city.
3. The amount necessary to defray the expenses of the
Board of Education for the fiscal year including all capital app-
ropriations.
4. The amount necessary to defray the general city
expenses of said city for the current fiscal year as authorized and
provided for in this act and in all other acts relating to the city

including the Local Finance Law.


5. Taxes shall be collected as follows: One warrant which includes taxes to be levied for all the above purposes shall be issued and the said warrant shall provide for the payment of said taxes in six equal installments; the first installment to be due on March 15th in each year; the second installment to be due on April 15th in each year; the third installment to be due on May 15th in each year; the fourth installment to be due on June 15th in each year; the fifth installment to be due on July 15th in each year and the sixth installment to be due on August 15th in each year, except such dates as fall on Saturday, Sunday or legal holidays, the next business date shall be the due date for that installment. Nothing contained herein however shall present the payment by any taxpayer of the total amount of his annual tax and charges after the issuance of said warrant.

Section 2. Laws Repealed.- Local Law No. 1 of 1932- Local Law No. 3 of 1935 and Local Law No. 2 of 1940 are hereby repealed.


Section 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect immediately upon public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
