LOCAL LAW NO. 18 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the
Laws of 1902 as amended by the various Local Laws to date. In this
instance giving the Common Council the power and authority to fix
the compensation of city officials and city employees and further
providing for additional compensation for the Corporation Counsel
in difficult or important cases.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the
City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902
as amended to date, is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 11. Compensation of city officials and city
employees. Members of the Planning Board, Members of the
Plumbing Board, Members of the Board of Health, Members of the
Library Board, Members of the Park and Beach Commission, Members
of the Youth Commission, Members of the Municipal Airport Comm-
ission, except the Secretary, and Members of the Board of Educat-
ion, except the Clerk, shall receive no compensation for their
services. The salaries of all other city officials and city
employees shall be fixed by the Common Council. The Common
Council shall have the power to increase, at any time, the com-
pensation of officers and employees of any office or position and

order the payment of the same out of the treasury of the city, such increased compensation may be made after such salary or compensation shall have been fixed and provided for in the budget of the city for the fiscal year. The Corporation Counsel, may however, for the conduct, argument, prosecution or defense of important litigation, cases or proceedings in which the city is an interested party, receive such additional compensation as in the opinion of the Common Council will reasonably compensate him for the special and extra services rendered or performed in behalf of the city in the prosecution or defense of such important, difficult or unusual proceedings which extra compensation shall be in addition to the fixed salary of the Corporation Counsel and such additional compensation may be fixed by the Common Council may be made from any special funds or unestimated receipts unappropriated which are available for such purposes.


Section 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
