LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1956

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION OF POLICE-WOMAN
IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH,
NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: THERE IS HEREBY CREATED IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT,
THE POSITION OF POLICE-WOMAN, WHICH SHALL BE HELD BY A WOMAN, AND
SHALL BE IN THE COMPETITIVE CLASS OF THE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE.

THE SAID POLICE-WOMAN SHALL HAVE THE SAME RANK AND SHALL RE-
CEIVE THE SAME SALARY AS A PATROLMAN.

SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AFTER PUBLIC
HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.


ON ROLL CALL, ALDERMAN HOLLAND, BRAULT, VILLONI, JABAUT,
