

AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH NEW YORK, HELD DECEMBER 18, 1958.

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1958

ENTITLED AN ACT AMENDING LOCAL LAW No. 3 OF 1958.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 2 OF LOCAL LAW No. 3 OF 1958 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS REGARDING THE PRESENT INCUMBENT IN THE POSITION OF SENIOR CLERK IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT:

SECTION 2. LOCAL LAW No. 3 OF 1958 IS HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 3-A. PROMOTIONS, DEMOTIONS, TRANSFERS

1. PERSONNEL PROMOTED SHALL RECEIVE THAT SALARY IN THE RANGE PRESCRIBED FOR THE POSITION TO WHICH HE OR SHE IS PROMOTED WHICH IS ONE INCREMENT OF THE NEW SALARY GRADE HIGHER THAN THE SALARY RATE HE OR SHE PREVIOUSLY WAS RECEIVING. FOR THOSE PERSONNEL RECEIVING LONGEVITY INCREMENTS, THE MAXIMUM SALARY WITHOUT LONGEVITY OF THE POSITION TITLE PREVIOUSLY HELD SHALL BE USED IN DETERMINING THE APPLICABLE SALARY RATE FOR THE PROMOTION.. THEREUPON, ELIGIBILITY FOR LONGEVITY PAY SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF LOCAL LAW No. 3 OF 1958.

2. PERSONNEL DEMOTED SHALL RECEIVE THAT SALARY IN THE LOWER CLASSIFICATION CORRESPONDING TO THE INCREMENT STEP PREVIOUSLY RECEIVED IN THE HIGHER POSITION. ELIGIBILITY FOR LONGEVITY PAY SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF LOCAL LAW No. 3 OF 1958.

3. PERSONNEL TRANSFERRED FROM ONE DEPARTMENT OR UNIT TO ANOTHER AND CONTINUING IN THE SAME POSITION TITLE SHALL RECEIVE THE SAME SALARY RATE.


SECTION 3. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT.

THIS ACT SHALL BE IN EFFECT ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1, 1959, AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.


ON ROLL CALL, ALDERMEN HOLLAND, BRAULT, GIOIOSA, JABAUT, AND
