LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1965

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 12 OF LOCAL LAW NO. 12 OF 1964, REGARDING AN EMPLOYER OF RECORD AS PER SECTION 119-0 OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1, PARAGRAPH 3 OF LOCAL LAW NO. 12 OF 1964 IS HEREBY AMENDED REGARDING AN EMPLOYER OF RECORD AS PER SECTION 119-0 OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW AS FOLLOWS:

PARA - 3 (A) THAT THE SAID COUNCIL SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO EMPLOY WORKING PERSONNEL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THEIR APPROPRIATION FROM WHATEVER SOURCE THE MONIES MAY BE RECEIVED AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH.

(B) THAT FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN SECTION 119-0 OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW, THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH SHALL BE DESIGNATED THE EMPLOYER OF THE PERSONNEL REFERRED TO IN (A) ABOVE.


SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.

ON ROLL CALL, ALDERMEN BOOTH, DUKEN, SABOURIN, BRANON AND FLYNN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE; NO ONE IN THE NEGATIVE; (ALDERMAN BEAUVAIS BEING ABSENT) CARRIED.
