

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburg, New York, held September 10, 1943.

PRESENT: Alderman Holland, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demery, Behan, and Tyrell.

ABSENT: Mayor Bouyer, Alderman Holland presiding as Acting Mayor.

By Alderman Tyrell; seconded by Alderman Demery:

LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 1943.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 26 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by Local Law No. 18 of 1942, in this instance providing for the appointment and compensation of a Deputy City Clerk.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburg, New York:


SECTION 1. The last paragraph of Section 26 of the City Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

There shall also be a Deputy City Clerk, whose office shall be placed in the competitive class of the Municipal Civil Service of the City of Plattsburg, New York, and the appointment of which shall be made by the Mayor in accordance with the Municipal Civil Service Laws of the City of Plattsburg. Said Deputy City Clerk shall possess the same powers as the City Clerk, as specified herein, and his compensation shall be on appointment, as follows: The entrance or minimum salary shall be \$2300.00, the same to increase at the rate of \$100.00 per year, until the maximum of \$2500.00 is reached, \$800.00 of which compensation shall be payable out of the General Fund and the balance shall be payable out of the Water Fund and Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund, in equal amounts. Provided, however, that for all positions where there is a fixed minimum and maximum salary, that all increases shall become effective September 1st, 1943, for persons who have occupied their respective positions for a period of more than one (1) year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of September 1st, 1943, after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Alderman Holland, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demery, Behan and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative,
CARRIED.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Local Law No. 5 of 1942, providing for the minimum and maximum compensation, rate of increase and the time of taking effect of such increase for the employees of the Municipal Lighting Department of the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y.

LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1943.

ENTITLED AN ACT creating specific titles for positions occupied by employees of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, fixing their compensation, and providing for vacations and sick leaves.

LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 1943.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 26 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by Local Law No. 18 of 1942, in this instance providing for the appointment and compensation of a Deputy City Clerk.
